Spring cleaning is a great way to refresh your home, but safety should always come first. Here are some essential safety tips:

Declutter - Remove tripping hazards like cords, rugs, and clutter before starting.

Lift Properly -Bend at the knees and lift with your legs to avoid back strain.

Read Labels – Follow instructions and warnings on cleaning products.

Never Mix Chemicals –Avoid dangerous combinations like bleach and ammonia, it creates toxic fumes.

Check Tools - Ensure outdoor equipment (lawnmowers, power washers, etc.) is in good condition.
